On-Site Activities

These activities are free, on-site, and don't require a sign-up. Just choose your adventure and enjoy!

LEADER LEAD - Participate in these activities DIY-style by using the provided materials and instructions. Adults from your group will be required to help girls complete these activities.

HOSTED - Participate in these activities with the help of adult and girl facilitator hosts. All materials provided. Adults from your group must be present, but the adult/girl facilitators will lead the activity.

"Choose Your Own" Social - HOSTED Friday 7-9 PM Level 3

Friday evening, the choice is yours' from 7-9pm. Girls can choose to chill and watch an outdoor movie with popcorn, have some s'mores and sign-a-long by the campfire, or get their groove on at our crafty dance party at the lodge...or all three! Stay together as a troop or explore all the activities in the approved area with a buddy.

- There will be adult supervision in all three areas.
- Leaders need to stay in the area but they do not have to stay with their girls.
- Leaders should choose a meeting spot and make sure their girls know how to find them.
- No running after sunset.
- Any girls breaking rules or not following the Girl Scout Law will be asked to stay with their leader for the remainder of the social.
- The Adventure Treehouse is off-limits during the social.

7 Principals Games (All Levels) - LEADER LEAD Saturday 9 AM - 5 PM Level 3 - Lodge

The 7 principles of Leave No Trace aren't a game...or are they? Follow the provided instructions to have fun with your friends while learning how to leave the outdoors better than you found them.

Adventure Tree House (All Levels) - LEADER LEAD Sunrise to Sunset Daily (except at the Friday Night Social) Level 3

Who doesn't like a tree house?! Adults must supervise girls on the treehouse at all times (closed from sunset to sunrise).

Basic Knife Skills (Daisy) - HOSTED Saturday 1-5pm Level 3 - Picnic Tables

Learn the "arc of safety" and how to keep your fingers and friends safe when you use a knife. Girls will learn age appropriate knife safety skills while making a tasty snack from fruit!.

Knife Skills (Brownies+) - HOSTED Saturday 1-5pm Level 3 - Picnic Tables

Learn the "arc of safety" and how to keep your fingers and friends safe when you use a knife. Girls will learn age appropriate knife safety skills while trying their hand at whittling a bar of soap.

Knots (All Levels) - LEADER LEAD Saturday 9 AM - 5 PM Level 2 - Picnic Tables

Follow the provided instructions to help your girls master the most useful knots for their age. Daisies, learn how to tie your shoes! Already know that? How about a square knot or a clove hitch, two everyday knots with many uses. Older girls can try their hand at a bowline, a great "fixed" loop knot for tent stakes that's easy to untie after it's been under load. What about a taut line hitch for those dunk bags?!

Friendship Bracelets (All Levels) - LEADER LEAD Saturday 9 AM - 5 PM Level 2 - Picnic Tables

Just chill and make a friendship bracelet, traditional string your thing? Go for it. How about a swiftie-style beaded bracelet? The choice is yours'. Follow the provided instructions to help your girls use their new knot skills to make a friendship bracelet.

Campfire (All Levels) - HOSTED Saturday 7 - 8:30 PM Level 3 - Campfire Ring

Wind down beside a crackling fire and share a skit or a song with your new Girl Scout friends. Sign-ups will be posted in the Level 1 lodge on Saturday morning.

SWAPS (All Levels) - LEADER LEAD All day, every day!

Bring SWAPS (Special Whatchamacallits Affectionately Pinned Somewhere) from home or craft them at camp (bring your own supplies). Make them, swap them, and bring home a special home-made souvenir of your new friends from camp!
